

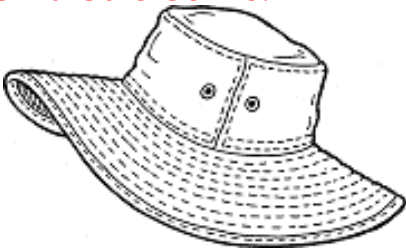


# Approved Sunsmart Hats for Stepping Stones Child Care Centre.

Stepping Stones Child Care Centre has been approved as a Sunsmart Centre by **The ACT Cancer Council & The Cancer Council VICTORIA**.

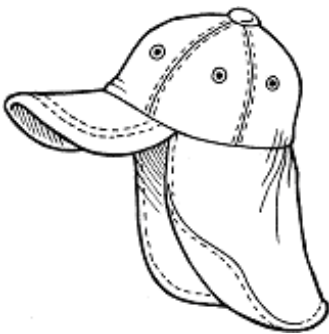
The following hats are approved by **The ACT Cancer Council & The Cancer Council VICTORIA** for use in our Childcare setting as well as for home and everyday use.

**Please note that Caps and visors are not approved hats and cannot be worn at Stepping Stones Child Care Centre.**



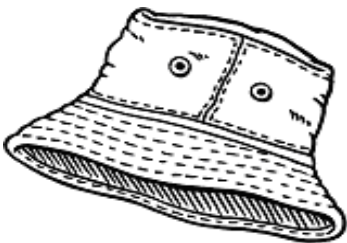
## ✓ Broad-brimmed hat

Brim should be at least 7.5cm wide and be an appropriate fit for their head, ensuring their face is well shaded.



## ✓ Legionnaire hat

Hats should have a flap that covers the neck. The flaps and the front peak should meet to protect the side of the face, neck and ears.



## ✓ Bucket hat

The brim width of the hat should be an appropriate fit for their head and shade their face well (no less than 6cm brim).
