

Sun Screen Procedures

***Staff will apply a 30+ broad spectrum sunscreen to children 20 minutes before morning play and then re-apply 20 minutes before afternoon play**



*** Staff will apply sunscreen before going outside for sun protection and role modelling sun safety to the children**

*** Staff will assist children when applying sunscreen to their faces, necks, ears, arms and legs**

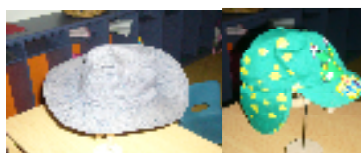


*** Staff will wear gloves or use a tissue when applying sunscreen to children. New gloves or tissues are used for each child.**



*** Staff & children will wear hats approved by the Cancer Council ACT every time they go outside.**

***Spare hats are provided for children and staff. If this supply is exhausted children and staff will play in shaded areas.**
